




Fig. 32. Remove/refit cantrail fillet

Release each door furflex adjacent to the cantrail fillet. Using a thin screwdriver, carefully prise the cantrail fillet retaining clips out of their holes in the cantrail, and remove the fillet. (See Fig. 32).

Repeat these operations on the other side of the car.

Carefully ease the headlining away from the roof panel and remove.

All traces of foam rubber must be removed from the roof panel prior to fixing the new lining.



Offer up the new lining to the roof panel, and mark it carefully, to ensure that it is fitted in its exact position when the adhesive is applied. Use Bostik IGA. 147 adhesive for the roof lining.

Apply the adhesive to the roof panel only, and when tacky, fit the roof lining, taking care to avoid wrinkling the material.




Fig. 33. Remove/refit backlight fillet

Using the same method, carefully remove the fillet above the backlight. (See Fig. 33).

The refitting operation is then a reversal of the removal procedure.

Refer to the appropriate paragraphs for refitting the windscreen and quarter lights.
